Usage

- room, building, street, town, country
- book, paper etc.
 - car, taxi
 - picture, world
 - meaning *next to, by an object*
 - for *table*
 - for events
 - place where you are to do something typical (watch a film, study, work)
 - attached
 - for a place with a river
 - being on a surface
 - for a certain side (left, right)
 - for a floor in a house
 - for public transport
 - for television, radio
- by, next to,
besideleft or right of somebody or
something
 - on the ground, lower than (or covered by) something else
 - lower than something else but above ground
 - covered by something else
 - meaning more than
 - getting to the other side (also *across*)
 - overcoming an obstacle
